Services will be held on Monday, September 17 in Sprague, Washington, his hometown. A graveside service will be held at 10:30 a.m. at the town cemetery and a memorial service at 11:00 a.m. at the Sprague Community Church.

Chuck spent his life loving and serving the people of Lima, Peru as a missionary church planter with ABWE. He and his wife Judy raised Ruth, Sarah and Steve in that ministry. Steve and his family follow him in that ministry. Judy preceded him in death. Both had fought cancer and continued to serve. Jean, his second wife, whom he met on the field, returned to the States to

help NBHM start ministry to Hispanics in the northwest in cooperation with ABWE. Two of his Peruvian colleagues, Juan Carlos Magallanes and Pablo Silva and their families joined them. Until Chuck's health declined, he pursued the ministry with the same intensity and grace that had always characterized him. In the last few months, Ruth and Sarah and their families were able to be of great assistance to him and Jean in his second bout with cancer following heart surgery. We in the northwest will miss him greatly.
